Become a travelsmart officer. Buy an electric bike • try and walk short distances instead of taking the car 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • change lighting back to eco saving • minibus/carpool from central locations eg train station to encourage use of public transport • recommend low petrol use replacement cars • carpooling program. Bonus incentives less travel for staff. Staff bulletin for giveaways, exchanging/ recycling goods, carpooling, sharing • give more incentives to use public transport • purchasing cars with reduced fuel emissions • bonus incentives for not using car and carpooling • encourage subdivisions for high density living.
